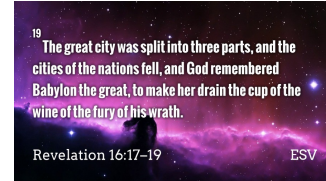
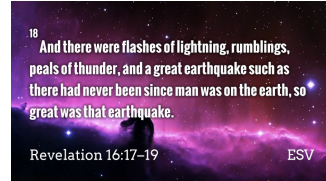
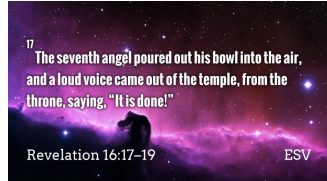
Complete TimeLine
